



## 2016 Falls Pointe Piranhas Swim Team Code of Conduct

*In order for all members of the team to enjoy themselves and keep themselves safe during practices and meets, swimmers are expected to:*

- Follow all directions the first time given.
- Respect the coach, assistant coaches and parents who are in charge.
- Participate in daily practice.
- Refrain from using alcohol, drugs or tobacco during practices or at meets.
- Use proper language at all times. No swearing, vulgar language or spitting.
- Never interfere with the progress of another swimmer – during practice or meets.
- Behave in such a way that their actions reflect positively on the team at all functions.

Team members who violate these rules are subject to the following warning system:

1 <sup>st</sup> warning	<b>Warned</b> by coaches or adults in charge.
2 <sup>nd</sup> warning	<b>Sent home</b> for the day and parental notification is made.
3 <sup>rd</sup> warning	If a swimmer has to be sent home a <u>second time in one week</u> , he/she will be <b>removed from the line-up of the next meet.</b>
